After award of contract, Successful Bidder can upload scanned copy of the DD in place of PBG and has to

ensure delivery of hard copy to the original DD to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.

  2. Bidder are requested to note that Technical Evaluation of the bid is based on technical compliance sheet attached in buyer added bid specific ATC documents. Technical specifications as per Annexure-A attached in ATC shall prevail over GeM Category specifications.
  3. Annexure-I attached in Buyer Added bid specific ATC Document: Self-declaration by Bidder on their company's letterhead as well as on OEM's letterhead for compliance as per Rule 144(xi) of GFR 2017. Self declaration in form of Annexure-I to be submitted by bidder as part of their bid documents on their letterhead duly signed and stamped with official seal as well as on OEM's letterhead also.
  4. Annexure-II attached in Buyer Added bid specific ATC Document: Self-declaration in proof of Annexure-II to be submitted by Bidder on their company's letterhead as well as on OEM's letterhead for compliance to Make In India.
  5. Bidder other than OEM need to submit Bid specific OEM Authorization/Manufacturing Authorization Form(MAF) from OEM.

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.

6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM.
