ARTICLE 1: SUBJECT OF THE TASK ORDER No. I-I/XXX/CRYOSTAT/IO/2023-24 dated XX.XX.XXXX

The subject and scope of the Task Order shall be defined as under:

1.1. INDA shall be responsible for the scope of work (i.e. delivery on DAP – ITER Organization, Route de Vinon sur Verdon CS 90046, 13067 St Paul-Lez-Durance, France INCOTERMS 2010). The details are as under;

- 1.1.1. Consignments are to be transported from M/s Vacuum Techniques Pvt. Ltd. 2/13, 1st Stage, 1st Phase, Peenya Industrial Area, Bangalore, Karnataka 560058 to CFS Nhava Sheva/JNPT Nhava Sheva, CFS activities and thereafter transporation upto JNPT Nhava Sheva Port.
- 1.1.2. Customs Clearance and other documentation at CFS/JNPT Nhava Sheva.
- 1.1.3. CFS, THC, Shipping Line Charges/Surcharges, Dangerous/Hazardous Goods Charges, Lift-on Charges and etc. at origin (CFS/JNPT Nhava Sheva).
- 1.1.4. Ocean Transportation from JNPT, India to Fos Sur Mer, France
- 1.1.5. Ad Valorem Insurance from Origin to Final Destination.

1.2. The responsibility for sharing of financial obligations by INDA and F4E (European Domestic Agency) and risk/liabilities shall be the same as already agreed in MOU, the Global Transport, Logistics and Insurance contract IO/CFT/12/6000000085 dated 10 February 2012,

Implementation Agreement. And also agreed in Rate Contract I-I/RC/CON/007/LSP/2014-15 dated 22.09.2015.

1.3. INDA's financial obligation for delivery of the consignment **excludes terminal handling charges/inetracting at Fos Sur Mer France** and transportation costs from Fos Sur Mer to the ITER site St. Paul-Lez-Durance, France (Free on truck) which shall be borne by F4E in accordance with international agreements between the ITER members.

1. **The First Phase of Transportation:** INDA shall be responsible for taking delivery of the consignment from M/s Vacuum Techniques Pvt. Ltd. Bangalore to CFS/JNPT Nhava Sheva and until delivery on Board Fos Sur Mer (GPM) France.
2. **Second Phase of Transportation:** F4E (EUDA) shall be financially responsible for until delivery on DAP (Free on Truck) ITER-Site St. Paul-Lez-Durance, France.

ARTICLE 2: PRICE OF THE TASK ORDER

Note 1. Terminal Handling Charges (THC), Shipping Line Charges/Surcharge, Dangerous/Hazardous Goods Charges, Lift on and CFS Charges shall be paid at actuals on the basis of submission of documentary proof. Applicable taxes, duties and statutory levies shall be paid extra & duties as per prevailing rate.

Note 2. Any charges related to customs inspection, container storage charges and container detention/demurrage charges if any at origin or destination shall be extra and will be paid at actuals against submission of documentary proofs when solely attributable to INDA.

Note 3. Retention charges for mechanical trailers and hydraulic axle will be nil for the first four days from the date of reporting of the vehicle at the collection point.

Note 4. Ocean Transportation of 20 ft Flat Rake Container should be performed under deck

Note 5. Detention Charges for Trailers, additional loading/unloading (if any) is included in the scope of the contractor.

Note 6. No taxes and duties of any other country except India shall be paid by the Purchaser.

Note 7. The complete payment will be made in Indian Rupees only as per the exchange rate declared by the RBI Reference rate, prevailing on the date of Bill of Lading.

Note 8. The Payment for F4E Contribution will be paid by F4E. The amount mentioned above is for reference purpose only.

Note 9. Cost of Ad-Valorem Insurance premium shall be determined based on the C&F Value of the shipment.

** The number of Man Days and Interventions mentioned above are estimated and to be invoiced according to actual number of Man Days and Interventions performed. The same is to be invoiced according to actual number of intervention(s) performed based on the Certificate submitted by the Survey Company/Insurance Company and countersigned by DAHER/Local Logistics Service Provider. The payment will be done only on the basis of the rates quoted & the number of interventions performed. No other charges will be reimbursed.

ARTICLE 4: GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- 4.1. **Type of Transport:** Multimodal Transportation (Road and Ocean Transportation) of Qty: XX – 20 ft FR (Flat Rake, Out of Gauge) Container & XX – 20 ft GP Container.
- 4.2. **Description of Item:** TCPH & its loose items as per mentioned in the Packing List I-I/ CRYOSTAT/EXPORT/1717 /2023-24
- 4.3. Good Quality Waterproof Tarpaulin should be used for covering of the Consignments/Containers while Multimodal Transportation (Road & Ocean transportation) as well as storage without any cost to ITER-India (IPR) - INDA.

ARTICLE-5: PAYMENTS

5.1. Payment will be made within 30 days from the date of receipt of error free invoice along with all the documents mentioned below which are to be submitted after delivery of the consignment at ITER-Site. The complete payment will be made in Indian Rupees only. The complete payment will be made in Indian Rupees only as per the exchange rate declared by the RBI Reference rates, prevailing on the date of Bill of Lading. Further, in case of delivery of the consignment to the interim storage facility in Marseille region other than ITER-Site, the payment terms agreed in Amendment-I to the Implementation Agreement I-I/LSP/01/13-14 dated 16th October, 2013 shall apply.

- The relevant original invoices in duplicate indicating the reference number of the Contract, Implementation Agreement and the reference of the Task Order number to which they refer along with any other supporting document for claimed amount.
- Clean, Stamped on Board and duly signed Bill of Lading.
- A copy of Insurance Certificate/Declaration.
- A copy of Shipping Bill with the related documents if any (for Export).
- A duly signed Shipment Delivery Certificate as per the packing list by the Receiver including all its annexes.
- Original(s) of LR for Local Road Transportation.
- Receipts in original w.r.t. Statuary payments, Stamp Duty, Duties, Wharfage for which LLSP (Local Logistics Service Provider) is claiming reimbursement.
- All copies of receipts duly signed by LLSP w.r.t. Port Charges, Shipping Line Charges (such as THC, BL, DO Charges, Co-Loader Charges, surcharges etc.), Security Charges, ICD/CFS Charges, Insurance Survey Fees etc. for which LLSP is claiming reimbursement.

5.2. Payments shall be made to the Local Logistics Service Provider through Cheque/RTGS/NEFT

ARTICLE 6 – TAXATION

6.1. The Local Logistics Service Provider shall have sole responsibility for compliance with the tax laws which apply to it.

6.2. Only if the direct exemption of taxes and duties at the source is legally not possible, the Local Logistics Service Provider shall invoice them.

6.3. The Local Logistics Service Provider shall be responsible for making payment of GST or any applicable Tax at the time of invoicing to the Indian Tax Authorities.

6.4. Applicable Income Tax (TDS) will be deducted from the bills/invoices at the prevailing rate and the necessary TDS Certificate shall be issued.
