1 Essential Eligibility Criteria

Bidders who meet all Essential Eligibility Criteria given below only shall be considered for further evaluation. Bidder as mentioned in the Table 1 means: single company/industry. Bidder must submit two sets of original documents or attested copies of original documents as evidence for meeting the criteria. Meeting the Essential Eligibility criteria given below is only a first step in technical evaluation.

2.4 Procedure for obtaining Tender Documents	
a.	Tender Documents are available on ITER-India web site (www.iter-india.org) under “Tender” menu for

- b. Alternatively tender documents in hardcopy form can also be obtained directly (in person/by post) from the Purchase Officer, ITER-India by submitting the prescribed Tender Fees. The hard copy of Tender documents in this mode shall be issued up to 05th August 2019.
- c. Issue of tender documents does not mean that a Potential Bidder is automatically qualified to submit bids. ITER-India's decision to consider as to whether a bidder has met with the EEC is final.

2.5 Pre-bid Meeting

- a. In-person Pre-bid meeting(s) will be held at ITER-India office (Block-A, Sangath Skyz, Bhat-Motera Road, Koteswar, Ahmedabad – 380005, India) on 12th July 2019, Time – 11:30 am onwards
- b. Potential bidders will be required to **register for the Pre-Bid Meeting** to confirm their participation in the prescribed format (refer Annexure-A1/Section:[3.1](#)), latest by 9th July 2019.
- c. The detailed agenda of meeting will be sent in advance to those who register for the pre –bid meeting.
- d. The main objective of the Pre-Bid Meeting is to ensure all the tender requirements that are specified through different tender documents have been clearly and correctly understood by all the potential bidders.
- e. The potential bidders are required to furnish in writing their pre-bid queries (both technical and commercial) latest by 9th July 2019. Outstanding queries and clarifications if any after the pre-bid meeting shall be submitted preferably by 2nd August 2019 (Refer Section: [2.1](#)). If the queries submitted by the bidders are in parts, then latest query should have all previous queries separated and marked properly, so that earlier information is available in consolidated form at a single point. The bidders are required to raise the queries if any, strictly as per the enclosed format (Section:[3.2](#)/Annexure-A2) and send them to the Purchase Officer, ITER-India.
- f. Queries/clarification/information sought in any other manner may not be responded
- g. The potential bidder's queries / clarifications / information will also be discussed during Pre-bid meeting. Pre-bid clarifications will be issued to all the potential bidders through e-mail and shall be uploaded on the ITER-India Website under the "Tender" menu
- h. In case a potential bidder makes any alternative suggestions with respect to the tender requirements, the same will be discussed and noted for further evaluation by ITER-India. However, ITER-India reserves the right to accept or reject such suggestions at its discretion.
- i. Any modification(s) to the tender documents, which may become necessary as a result of the pre-bid meeting or other, shall be uploaded on the ITER-India web site and also communicated to all potential bidders through e-mail.
- j. The bidder(s) who could not attend the pre-bid meeting due to any reason, can also submit their bid in hard copy (in duplicate) as per the tender requirements.

2.6 Amendments to tender documents

a.	The Purchaser reserves the right to issue any amendments, clarifications, etc. to the tender documents, giving reasonable time, and prior to the bid opening. Such amendments, clarifications etc., to be taken into account by the bidders while submitting the bids and invariably enclose such documents as a part of the bid. All such amendments, clarifications, etc., shall be uploaded to ITER-India website and also notified through e-mail to those bidders who have already registered for the Pre-bid meeting(refer section: 2.5 (b)).The Purchaser will bear no responsibility or liability arising out of non-receipt of the same in time or otherwise.
2.7 Tender Fee & EMD	
a.	The completed bids should be submitted along with Tender Fees and Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) as per the following details referring to the bid submission format
b.	Tender Fee (Non-Refundable): Bidder shall submit a tender fee of INR 1180.00 (amount inclusive of GST) (Indian Rupees One Thousand One hundred and Eighty only) in the form of a Demand Draft (DD) or through Real Time Gross Settlement (RTGS) or through NEFT (National Electronic Funds Transfer) as per the details given below.
c.	Earnest Money Deposit (EMD): Bids must be submitted along with Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) for INR 10,00,000.00 (Indian Rupees Ten lacs only) by a Demand Draft or through RTGS or through NEFT (National Electronic Funds Transfer) as per the details mentioned below.
d.	The DD shall be drawn in favor of <u>Institute for Plasma Research A/c ITER-India</u> and payable at Ahmedabad, INDIA . Bidder's name and tender number shall be indicated on the reverse side of the Demand Draft. The DD in case of INR shall be from State Bank of India (SBI) or from any of the Nationalized banks or one of the banks namely ICICI Bank, IDBI Bank, HDFC Bank, and AXIS Bank. Demand Draft (DD) should not be prior dated to the date of advertisement.
e.	EMD/Tender Fees can be submitted through RTGS (Real Time Gross Settlement)/ NEFT (National Electronic Fund Transfer) by bidders prior to bid submission due date (Ref: section 2.9.3) . The proof of the RTGS/ NEFT shall be submitted in Envelope-1.1 of the bid document as per section: 2.17.2 . All charges for RTGS/ NEFT shall be borne by the bidder.

g.	EMD of successful bidder will be returned, without any interest, after signing the contract and after receipt of error free Security Deposit (SD) Bank Guarantee.
h.	EMD of unsuccessful bidder will be returned, without any interest, after the award of Contract (s).
i.	The EMD shall be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or amends or impairs or derogates from the submitted tender in any respect within the period of its validity. The Purchaser shall charge applicable GST, prevailing at that time on amount of EMD forfeited.

- j. **Bids received (except bidders registered with National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC), Directorate of Purchase and Stores (DPS) and Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) & such bidders furnishing proof of valid certificate or any other valid proof) without the prescribed Tender Fee and EMD shall not be considered for further evaluation.**

2.8 Preparation of Bids & Bid Content

2.8.1 General

- a. Before preparing the bids, the Bidders **must read and understand all the tender documents very carefully**. Bidders submitting the bids against this tender shall be deemed to have read and understood the tender in totality.
- b. Detailed instructions and format for preparing the tender response and its content is provided at section: 2 of this document. Different templates and formats have been provided to assist the bidders.
- c. The bids shall be prepared in duplicate. Each shall be clearly marked as “Original” or “Duplicate”. In the event of any discrepancy between them, the original shall prevail.
- d. The bid documents shall be prepared in English language only.
- e. All pages of the bid documents shall be numbered. Each page of the bid document shall be stamped and initialized.

2.8.2 Technical Bid Preparation

- a. Bidders must furnish all the necessary details against tender specifications provided in the Tender documents. Bidders need to fill, sign and stamp Annexure-A4 – “Technical & commercial bid format” and Annexure-A5 “Letter for acceptance of Section-A&B of tender” and to be submitted with the bid.
- b. Additionally a soft copy of the **Section-A & B bid submission content should** be prepared in the form of **CD/DVD/USB Flash Drive** for submission. **Section-C (Price Bid) must NOT be included in this soft copy (Section-A & B).**

2.8.3 Price Bids Preparation

- a. Refer to Price bid document (Section-C) for specific instructions and bid format on Price Bid preparation
- b. Bid should be free from Corrections and Erasures. Corrections, if any, must be attested. All total amounts shall be indicated both in words as well as in figures. Where there is difference between amounts quoted in words and figures, amount quoted in words shall prevail.
- c. Refer to Section-A (II) for Terms and Conditions of the Contract including the payment terms and submission of Bank Guarantees.

2.8.4 Loading Criteria for Price Comparisons of Bids:

- a. In case of deviation in payment terms including demand of advance other than specified in payment schedule and accepted by ITER-India, applicable rate of interest (prevailing 12%) will be loaded for price comparison purpose

2.9 Bid Submission

2.9.1 Bid Submission instructions

- a. Bidder shall submit full technical details, literature, their company profile, and commercial terms and conditions including the delivery period etc. as per the tender in Section-A & B of the bid.
- b. Refer to Section-3 of this document, for more details on bid submission envelopes, their format and their content
- c. All bids in response to this tender shall be submitted in TWO PART (Section – A & B and Section-C) in separate envelopes, duly sealed and superscripted with **Tender Notice Number , Due Date and Time** as per the details provided in Section-2 of this document. **An additional Main envelop covering Section-A, B and C envelopes should** be used to submit the bids as described at Section-2 of this document.
- d. All technical specifications and technical details along with commercial terms and conditions (**without price**) shall be included only in Section-A & B of the bid.
Section-C (Price bid) comprising of price details as per the price bid format only shall be submitted in a separate envelope only in Hard copy.
- e. The bidder shall take special care in order not to mix-up price details with the Section-A and B (Technical and Commercial bid without price) and vice versa. Any violation of these conditions may lead to rejection of the bid.
- f. The **Main envelope** containing bids shall also contain the EMD & Tender Fees enclosed in a separate envelope (refer to section-2 for details)
- g. The bidders are advised to use high quality plastic envelopes/covers to protect the bids from any damage in transit.
- h. If the envelopes are not sealed and marked as indicated in the tender, then the purchaser will assume no responsibility of pre-mature opening of the bid leading to the consequences such as rejection of bid, etc.
- i. Meeting Essential Eligibility Criteria is essential for further technical evaluation. Bidders unwilling to meet the Essential Eligibility Criteria in Table-1 need not submit bids.

2.9.2 Mode & Address of Bid Submission

- a. **Sealed bid documents can be sent by Speed Post/Registered Post/Courier at the address given below so as to reach by the stipulated due date and time. No responsibility will be taken for postal delay or**

non-delivery/non-receipt of Bid documents.

- b. Sealed bid documents can also be submitted **in person** at ITER-India office gate on or before the stipulated due date and time as per the following address

2.9.3 Due date for bid submission

- a. The completed bid documents in the prescribed format should be submitted to the Purchase Officer, ITER-India **latest by 13:00 hrs. (IST) on 19th August 2019.**
- b. Bidders are advised to prepare and submit their bids well in advance to the due date with due consideration of lead times required for an assured delivery by postal services to avoid unfortunate delays.
- c. ITER-India will not be responsible for any delay or loss of bid documents in transit.

2.9.4 Rejection of Late/Delayed Bids

- a. Bids received after the due date and specified time will be declared as **"LATE"**. Bids received after the opening of bids will be declared as **"DELAYED"**. **LATE and DELAYED bids WILL NOT be considered** and therefore, it is in the interest of the bidders to ensure that the tenders reach the Purchase Officer, ITER-India on or before the stipulated due date and time .

2.9.5 Validity of Bids

- a. The bids should be valid at least for 120 days from the date of opening of Section-A & B bids. In case of unforeseen delays in concluding the tender evaluation, ITER-India may request the bidders for a suitable extension of validity of their bids without any change in quoted price and terms & conditions.

2.10 Bid Opening of Section-A&B

- a. Bids will be opened in two stages (Stage-1: Section A & B & Stage-2: Section-C) at ITER-India office as indicated in this tender document.
- b. Section A & B (Technical and Commercial bid without price) will be opened in the presence of attending bidders or their authorized representatives.
- c. Unless otherwise advanced or postponed with advance intimation to the bidders, Section A & B **will be opened on the same date, that is on the bid submission due date (19th August 2019) at 14:30 hrs. (IST) in the presence of attending Bidders.**

d. Bidders who wish to participate in the opening of Section A & B may depute their representatives to ITER-India office on the specified date and time.

e. Bidders or their authorized representatives, who wish to attend the tender opening, should produce an authorization letter, failing which he/she may not be allowed to participate in the tender opening

2.11 Evaluation Committee (s)

a. ITER-India's evaluation committee(s) duly constituted by the competent authority of ITER-India will evaluate the techno-commercial bids. The committee(s) may seek clarifications, hold techno-commercial discussions and finally make appropriate recommendations to the competent authority of ITER-India as per the mandate of the committee(s). However the Purchase officer, ITER-India shall remain the single point of contact between ITER-India and the bidders.

b. At first the Section A & B bids will be evaluated against the specified Essential Eligibility Criteria (Refer Section A (I) for details).

2.12 Evaluation and clarifications of Section-A & B bids

a. The bids that are meeting all the Essential Eligibility Criteria stipulated in the Section-A(I) of the tender documents shall only be taken for further evaluation

b. The Purchaser reserves the right to invite the bidder(s) for technical and financial demonstration during the process of evaluation of their offer. The offer of bidder(s) failed to provide demonstration with supporting documents as called for by the Purchaser or who failed to provide or prove adequate technical and financial strength of their firms during such demonstration will be liable for rejection

c. If it becomes necessary to seek clarifications from the bidders regarding technical and commercial terms and conditions of the tender, the same will be sought from the bidders. In such an event, the bidder will furnish all the technical and commercial information/clarification to the Purchase Officer, ITER-India, on or before the date and time fixed for submission of such clarifications, by ITER-India. If the technical and commercial clarifications sought for, do not reach on or before the due date and time fixed, such bids are liable to be rejected without any further notice. Purchaser shall not bear the responsibility of delay in receipt of required clarification(s).

d. Further to clarify and confirm the compliance of the stated requirements, specific meetings with the bidders may be called by ITER-India. The venue, date and mode of the meeting (In person/Tele) shall be intimated to the bidder. Discussions will be held on the various aspects of the offer, including the deviations, if any, vis-à-vis tender requirements.

e. In the event of differences in commercial terms and conditions quoted by various bidders, ITER-India may resort to commercial discussions to bring all the bidders to common level of commercial terms and conditions.

f.	ITER-India and their authorized representatives may visit the bidder's or their sub-contractors if required, as part of technical evaluation process. It is in the interest of the bidder to give access to visit the important facilities. The representatives visiting the bidder or Sub-contractors will assess the their capability for meeting the required production rates and delivery schedule as mentioned in Section-A (II) of this tender. Findings by the representatives shall be considered as a part of technical evaluation and ITER-India reserves the right to reject the bid based on deficiency with respect to tender requirements, if found, during such visit.
g.	In case bidder makes any alternative suggestions with respect to the tender requirements, the same will be discussed and noted for further evaluation by ITER-India. However, ITER-India reserves the right to accept or reject such suggestions at its discretion.
h.	Where counter terms and conditions have been offered by the bidder, the same shall not be deemed to have been accepted by ITER- India, unless specific written acceptance thereof is obtained by ITER-India.
i.	All technical and commercial aspects pertaining to Section-A&B (Technical and Commercial bid without price) of the tender will be finalized prior to opening of Section-C (Price bid) and no change in this regard shall be accepted after opening of Section-C (Price bid).

2.12.1 Technically Qualified Bids

a.	Bids that are found to be compliant with the Essential Eligibility Criteria, the scope of work & supply, technical specifications and commercial terms & conditions specified in Section-A&B of the tender documents, shall be shortlisted as Technically Qualified Bids and shall be informed about Price-bid opening.
b.	Price bids (Section-C of bid) of only Technically Qualified Bids will be opened

2.12.2 Price bid Opening

a.	Only Technically Qualified bidders shall be informed or intimated of Price Bid opening
b.	Price bids (Section-C of bid) of only technically qualified bidders (Section: 2.12.2) shall be opened
c.	Date and time for opening of the Section-C will be decided by ITER-India and the same shall be intimated in advance only to the technically qualified bidders.
d.	Section-C (Price bid) will be opened in the presence of the attending technically qualified bidders or their authorized representatives.
e.	Bidders who wish to participate in the opening of Section-C may depute their representatives to ITER-India on the specified date and time. Those who are attending the tender opening should produce an authorization letter, failing which he/she may not be allowed to participate in the tender opening

2.13 Price Bid Evaluation

a.	The opened price bids will be evaluated and further clarifications, if any, may be sought from the respective bidders.

b.	The evaluation criteria and the basis for the price comparison are specified in Section-C document.
c.	Conditional discount, if any offered by the bidder shall not be considered and may lead to the rejection of the bid.
d.	The evaluation committee may hold discussions as per the approved procedure.
e.	The scope of supply, work, all technical specifications and terms & conditions agreed by the bidder in the Section-A&B bid and during Section-A & B evaluation shall prevail in case of any deviation(s) observed in Section-C.
