1 Essential Eligibility Criteria

Bids meeting the Essential Eligibility Criteria (EEC) shall only be considered as “Eligible Bids”. Bidder as mentioned in the EEC Table 1 means single Indian company/Indian industry. Bidder must submit two sets of self-attested copies of documents in support of eligibility criteria. However meeting the essential eligibility criteria in itself does not automatically qualify through the technical bid evaluation process.

2.3 Notice Inviting Tender/Tender Notification

a.	This is a TWO PART PUBLIC TENDER . Bidders shall submit bids in Two Part. As described in the tender process road map, bids will be evaluated at two stages.
b.	Section–A: Technical & Commercial Bid without price [Section-A(I), Section-B and Section-A (II)]
c.	Section–C: Price Bid

2.4 Tender Documents / Tender Specifications & Requirements

The scope of work, scope of supply, technical specifications, drawings, Contract terms and bidding procedures are prescribed in the tender documents. The tender documents include the following Parts. Each Part is provided in a separate document with appropriate title.

2.5 Procedure for obtaining Tender Documents



a.	Tender Documents are available on ITER-India web site https://www.iter-india.org/tenders under “Opportunities for Industry/ITER India Tenders” menu select Public/Global Tender option for download.
b.	Alternatively tender documents in hardcopy form can also be obtained directly (in person/by post) from the Sr. Officer (Purchase & Stores), ITER-India by submitting the prescribed Tender fee. The hard copy of Tender documents in this mode shall be issued up to 9th March, 2022 .
c.	Issue of tender documents does not mean that a Bidder is automatically qualified to submit bids. ITER-India’s decision to consider as to whether a bidder has met with the EEC or not is final.
2.6 Bidder eligibility and other applicable conditions	
a.	<p>Preference to Make In India (MII): Preference shall be given to Class-I Local Supplier as defined in Public Procurement (Preference to Make In India) Order 2017, as amended from time to time and its subsequent orders/notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific goods/products. The minimum local content to qualify as Class-I or Class-II Local Supplier is as per Government notification no. P-4501/2/2017-PP (BEII) dated 16.09.2020 issued by Ministry of Commerce & industry in this regard. Only Class-I Local Suppliers and Class-II Local Suppliers are eligible to bid for this tender. Non-Local Suppliers are not eligible to bid for this tender. Government notification no. P-4501/2/2017-PP (BEII) dated 16.09.2020 shall apply for this tender.</p> <p>Class-I Local Suppliers and Class-II Local Suppliers will submit duly signed Self-declaration under preference to Make in India order on their letter head as per Section 4.6 / Annexure-A6 Error! Reference source not found. along with the offer/bid failing which bid may not be considered for further evaluation.</p>
b.	Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises will get precedence over Preference to Make In India.
c.	No exemption with respect to “Bidder Turnover Criteria” and “Experience Criteria” will be given to a Micro or Small Enterprise.
d.	No exemption with respect to “Bidder Turnover Criteria” and “Experience Criteria” will be given to a Start-up recognized by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT).
e.	Orders (F. NO.6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd July 2020) issued by the Government of India restricting procurement from bidders of certain countries which shares a land border with India shall apply to this tender.

Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India (<https://mea.gov.in/india-and-neighbours.htm>), excluding countries as listed in the website of Ministry of External Affairs (<http://meadashboard.gov.in/indicators/92>), to which the Government of India has extended lines of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects (hereinafter called restricted countries') shall be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered (<https://dpiit.gov.in/sites/default/files/Revised-Format-Bidders-31March2021.pdf>) with the Registration committee constituted by the Department for promotion of Industry and Internal Trade(DPIIT). The bidders shall enclose valid registration certificate along with their offer. Wherever the bids are received without accompanying the above said requisite certificate such offers shall be treated as incomplete and not considered.

Self-declaration regarding bidder not belonging from a country which shares/not shares land border with India as per Section 4.7 /Annexure-A7 should be submitted along with bid documents.

2.7 Pre-bid Meeting

a. The main objective of the Pre-Bid Meeting is to ensure all the tender requirements that are specified through different tender documents have been clearly and correctly understood by all the potential/eligible bidders.

b. Pre-bid meeting will be held on **17th February 2022 Time – 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.**, remotely via MS Teams/in-person at ITER-India. Link for joining the pre-bid meeting/Venue for in-person pre-bid meeting will be sent to the registered bidders well in advance.

c. Eligible bidders will be required to register for the Pre-Bid Meeting to confirm their participation in the prescribed format (refer Section 4.4/ Annexure-A4), latest by **14th February, 2022. Scan copy of filled and signed Annexure-A4 can be sent through** email to **purchase@iterindia.in** and hard copy through courier/post mode.
However potential bidders who couldn't submit their registration form in advance may also be allowed to attend the pre-bid meeting provided they submit the registration form at the time of pre-bid meeting.
The bidders who could not attend the pre-bid meeting can also submit the bid as per the tender requirements and pre-bid clarifications issued by Purchaser.

d. In case of any change in the date and time for the Pre-Bid Meeting, the same will be informed to all the eligible bidders who have registered for the Pre Bid meeting. Details shall also be uploaded on ITER-India website.

e. **The eligible bidders are required to furnish in writing their pre-bid queries (both technical and commercial) latest by 14th February, 2022. Outstanding queries and clarifications if any after the pre-bid meeting shall be submitted preferably by 23rd February, 2022.** If the queries submitted by the bidders are in parts, then latest query should have all previous queries separated and marked properly, so that earlier information is available in consolidated form at a single point. The bidders are required to raise the queries if any, strictly as per the enclosed format (Section: 4.1/ Annexure-A1) and send them to the Sr. Purchase Officer, ITER-India vide email (**purchase@iterindia.in**) and hard copy to be sent vide courier/post.



f.	Queries/clarification/information sought in any other manner may not be responded
g.	Pre-bid clarifications will be issued to all the eligible bidders through e-mail and shall be uploaded on the ITER-India Website under the “Tender- Public/Global Tenders” menu
h.	In case eligible bidder makes any alternative suggestions with respect to the tender requirements, the same will be discussed and noted for further evaluation by ITER-India. However ITER-India reserves the right to accept or reject such suggestions at its discretion.
i.	Any modification(s) to the tender documents, which may become necessary, shall be uploaded as a corrigendum on the ITER-India Website under the “Tender- Public/Global Tenders” menu and also communicated to all potential bidders through e-mail.

2.8 Amendments to tender documents

a.	The Purchaser reserves the right to issue any amendments, clarifications, etc. to the tender documents, giving reasonable time, and prior to the bid opening. Such amendments, clarifications etc., to be taken into account by the bidders while submitting the bids and invariably enclose such documents as a part of the bid. All such amendments, clarifications, etc., shall be uploaded to ITER-India website and also notified through e-mail to registered bidders. The Purchaser will bear no responsibility or liability arising out of non-receipt of the same in time or otherwise.
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2.9 Tender Fee & EMD

a.	The completed bids should be submitted along with Tender fee and Declaration for Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) as per the following details referring to the bid submission format.
b.	Tender Fee (Non-Refundable): Bidder shall submit a tender fee of INR 1180.00 (Indian Rupees Five Hundred Ninety only) inclusive of applicable GST through Demand Draft (DD) or online through Real Time Gross Settlement (RTGS) or through NEFT (National Electronic Funds Transfer) as per the details given below, <u>along with bid submission.</u> <u>Note: Due to prevailing COVID-19 situation, bidders are advised to make payment of Tender Fee/EMD online through RTGS/NEFT and submit proof of payment of Tender Fee along with bid submission and intimate via email to purchase@iterindia.in.</u>
c.	Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) / Bid Security: Bidder shall submit EMD of INR 10 lacs for this tender in form of DD or online through RTGS or through NEFT as per details given below, along with bid submission.
d.	The DD shall be drawn in favour of <u>Institute for Plasma Research A/c ITER-India</u> and payable at <u>Ahmedabad, INDIA</u> . Bidder's name and tender number shall be indicated on the reverse side of the Demand Draft. f.	EMD of successful bidder will be returned, without any interest, after signing the contract and after receipt of error free Security Deposit (SD) Bank Guarantee. EMD of unsuccessful bidder will be returned, without any interest, after the award of Contract (s). The EMD shall be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or amends or impairs or derogates from the submitted tender in any respect within the period of its validity.
g.	Bidders registered with National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC), Directorate of Purchase and Stores (DPS), Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) & Start Ups are exempted for submission of Tender Fees and EMD against this tender subject to furnishing proof of valid certificate or any other valid proof. Bidders who do not fall under such exemption shall submit prescribed Tender Fee & EMD, failing which, such bid shall not be considered for further evaluation.
2.10 Preparation of Techno-commercial Bids & Bid Content	
2.10.1 General	
a.	Before preparing the techno-commercial bids, the Bidders shall read all the tender documents carefully. Bidder who has submitted the bid against this tender shall be deemed to have read and understood the tender in totality.
b.	Detailed instructions and format for preparing the tender response and its content is provided at Section: 2 of this document. Different templates and formats have been provided to assist the bidders.
c.	The bids shall be prepared in duplicate. Each shall be clearly marked as “ Original ” or “ Duplicate ”. In the event of any discrepancy between them, the original shall prevail.
d.	The bid documents shall be prepared in English language only.
e.	All pages of the bid documents shall be numbered. Each page of the bid document shall be stamped and initialized.
2.10.2 Techno-commercial Bid Preparation	
a.	Bidders shall furnish all necessary details against Tender specifications provided in the Tender documents.

- b. Additionally **a soft copy of the documents for compliance to EEC & Techno-commercial part –Section -A(I), A(II) and B** should be prepared in the form of **CD/DVD/USB Flash Drive** for submission. **Section-C (Price Bid) content shall be strictly avoided in this soft copy submission of the bids.**

2.10.3 Price Bids Preparation

- a. Refer to Price bid document (Section-C) for specific instructions and bid format on Price Bid preparation
- b. Bid should be free from Corrections and Erasures. Corrections, if any, must be attested. All total amounts shall be indicated both in words as well as in figures. Where there is difference between amounts quoted in words and figures, amount quoted in words shall prevail.
- c. Refer to Section-A (II) for Terms and Conditions of the Contract including the payment terms and submission of Bank Guarantees (BGs)

2.11 Bid Submission

- a. Bidder shall submit complete Tender document (single copy) duly stamped and signed by their competent authority. This will be considered as compliance to the tender document.
- b. Refer to Section-3 of this document, for more details on bid submission envelopes, their format and their content.
- c. All bids in response to this tender shall be submitted in **TWO PART** ([Section-A(I), Section-B & Section-A(II)] and Section-C) in separate envelopes, duly sealed and superscripted with **Tender Notice Number, Due Date and Time** as per the details provided in **Section-3** of this document. An additional Main envelope covering [Section-A(I), Section-B & Section-A(II)] and Section-C envelopes needs to be used to submit the bids as described at **Section-3** of this document.
- d. All technical specifications and technical details along with commercial terms and conditions (**without price**) shall be included only in Section-A and Section-B of the bid. **Section-C (Price bid)** comprising of price details as per price bid format only shall be submitted in a separate envelope **only in Hard copy.**
- e. The bidder shall take special care in order not to mix-up price details with the Section-A & Section-B (Technical and Commercial bid without price) and vice versa. Any violation of these conditions may lead to rejection of the bid.
- f. The Main envelope containing bids shall also contain the **Tender Fee/Proof of payment of Tender fee** and **EMD** enclosed in a separate envelope (refer to **Section-3** for details).
- g. The bidders are advised to use high quality plastic envelopes/covers to protect the bids from any damage in transit.



- h. If the envelopes are not sealed and marked as indicated in the tender, then the Purchaser will assume no responsibility of pre-mature opening of the bid leading to the consequences such as rejection of bid, etc.
- i. Bids received without the details asked for may not be considered.

2.11.2 Due date for bid submission

- a. The completed bid documents in the prescribed format should be submitted to the Sr. Officer (Purchase & Stores), ITER-India **latest by 13:00 hrs. (IST) on 16th March, 2022.**
- b. In the event of any date indicated above is a declared Holiday, the next working day shall become operative for the respective purpose mentioned herein.
- c. Bidders are requested to prepare and submit their bids well in advance to the due date with due consideration of lead times required for an assured delivery by postal services to avoid unfortunate delays.
- d. ITER-India will not be responsible for any delay or loss of bid documents in transit.

2.12 Rejection of Late/Delayed Bids

- a. Bids received after the due date and specified time will be declared as **“DELAYED”**. Bids received after the opening of bids will be declared as **“LATE”**. **DELAYED and LATE bids WILL NOT be considered** and therefore, it is in the interest of the bidders to ensure that the tenders reach the Sr. Officer (Purchase & Stores), ITER-India on or before the stipulated due date and time .
- b. The bids shall be valid at least for **120 days** from the date of opening of Section-A & Section-B bids. In case of unforeseen delays in concluding the tender evaluation, ITER-India may request the bidders for a suitable extension of validity of their bids without any change in quoted price and terms & conditions.



2.13 Bid opening of Section-A & Section-B

- a. Bids will be opened in Two stages (Stage-1: [Section-A(I), Section-B & Section-A(II)] Techno-commercial Bid opening & Stage-2: Section-C Price Bid opening at ITER-India office as indicated in this tender document).
- b. At the first stage [Section-A(I), Section-B & Section-A(II)] Technical and Commercial bid without price will be opened in the presence of attending bidders or their authorized representatives.
- c. Unless otherwise advanced or postponed with advance intimation to the bidders, Section-A(I), Section-B & Section-A(II) **will be opened on the same date, that is on the bid submission due date (16th March, 2022) at 14:30 hrs. (IST) in the presence of attending Bidders.**
- d. Bidders who wish to participate in the opening of Section-A & Section-B bid may **join online via MS Teams** on the specified date and time. MS Teams link for joining the bid opening will be shared with the bidders well in advance of bid opening.
- e. Bidders or their authorized representatives, who wish to attend (join online) the tender opening, should produce an authorization letter, failing which he/she may not be allowed to participate in the tender opening.

2.14 Evaluation Committee (s)

- a. ITER-India's evaluation committee(s) duly constituted by the competent authority of ITER-India will evaluate the bids. The committee(s) may seek clarifications, hold techno-commercial discussions and finally make appropriate recommendations to the competent authority of ITER-India as per the mandate of the committee(s). However, the Sr. Officer (Purchase & Stores), ITER-India shall remain the single point of contact between ITER-India and the bidders.

2.15 Evaluation and clarifications of Section-A and Section-B bids

- a. At first the submitted EEC documents will be evaluated against the specified Essential Eligibility Criteria (Refer Section-1 for the essential eligibility criteria details).
- b. The bids that are meeting all the Essential Eligibility Criteria stipulated Section- A (I) of the tender shall only be shortlisted as "**Eligible Bids**".
- c. The shortlisted "**Eligible bids**" shall only be considered for further detailed techno-commercial evaluation.
- d. If it becomes necessary to seek clarifications from the bidders regarding EEC, technical and commercial terms and conditions of the tender, the same will be sought through email from the bidders. In such an event, the bidder will furnish all the EEC, technical and commercial information/clarification to the Sr. Officer (Purchase & Stores), ITER-India, on or before the date and time fixed for submission of such clarifications, by ITER-India. If the EEC, technical and commercial clarifications sought for, do not reach on or before the due date and time fixed, such bids are liable to be rejected without any further notice. Purchaser shall not bear the responsibility of delay in receipt of required clarification(s).



e.	Further to clarify and confirm the compliance of the stated requirements, specific meetings with the bidders may be called by ITER-India. The venue, date and mode of the meeting (In person/ on-line) shall be intimated to the bidder. Discussions will be held on the various aspects of the offer, including the deviations, if any, vis-à-vis tender requirements.
f.	In the event of differences in commercial terms and conditions quoted by various bidders, ITER-India may resort to commercial discussions to bring all the bidders to common level of commercial terms and conditions.
g.	ITER-India and their authorized representatives may visit the Contractor/Sub-contractors, if required, as a part of technical evaluation process. Assessment made by ITER-India during the visit to the bidder shall be considered as an integral part of bid evaluation.
h.	In case, bidder makes any alternative suggestions with respect to the tender requirements, the same will be discussed and noted for further evaluation by ITER-India. However ITER-India reserves the right to accept or reject such suggestions at their discretion. In case of acceptance of such suggestion by ITER-India involving implication of price, same shall be intimated to all the participated bidders and all shall be granted permission to submit additional price bid/revised price bid, if required.
